Player Information And Responsibilities

Behaviour

The Club (GDCCWD) promotes competitive but fair play of the highest standard and supports the ideals and traditions of the game of cricket. All players must provide support to their captains, managers and team mates. Expressions of frustration, disappointment and anger are best conducted away from the team and spectators. Please pass any feedback or suggestions to your captain, manager or a member of the Committee.

Training

Training is a vital component of developing player skills. First and Second Grade members are expected to attend training every week. Attendance each week for other players is strongly preferred. Unless work or study commitments prevent from doing so players are expected to attend the complete session and are asked to notify their captain/manager during the season if they are unable to do so on any given week. Club gear is to be worn at each session including the Club training shirt, navy shorts and the club cap.

In cases of bad weather every attempt will be made to update the website.

Match day responsibilities

- Arrive at the ground 45-60 mins before the start time.
- If you are going to be late please call your captain/manager to let them know.
- Assist your captain/manager with covers, equipment, scoring, umpiring, drinks, scoreboard and garbage bins etc

Game availability

- Inform your captain/manager of any unavailabilities as soon as you are aware of them.
- Confirm your availability for each game by *no later than Tuesday 7pm of each week.*

Club fundraising and social events

It is the responsibility of each registered player to participate in Club fundraising activities, throughout the season (raffle tickets etc). Attendance and assistance at organised social functions would also be appreciated where you are available.
